SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR THIS EVENT:

EVENT INFORMATION:

- Desert style course consisting of mostly single track
- Terrain includes sand, rocks, hills, cactus. Watch for cattle on course.
- Course elevation 2200'-3600'
- Qualifier format with transfer sections and test sections
- Five (5) riders per row event start, rows starting on one (1) minute interval
- AA and A riders go 80 miles. 50A will be scored for this event at the end of the B loop, approximately 65 miles. 50As may run A loop if so desired to compete for National points. B classes = approx 65 mi.
- C, Sportsman and Youth = approx 42 mi.
- 3 locations for gas - remote gas available for the C loop, gas pit at the C finish/B loop start, and remote gas pit at B loop finish/A loop start.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Graded dirt road access. **Please** be highly aware we are operating under close monitoring of ALL dust generating activities in the Maricopa County and surrounding areas. Please keep your speed down when driving in and leaving the race area. We are counting on your help in keeping dust to an extreme minimum so we can do more events in this area. The monitoring agencies are very serious about this and we ask you to be as well.
- All persons entering the race area will be required to sign a release form holding harmless the AMA, OCMC, RMEC, and other entities.
- Overnight camping available Friday and Saturday October. 17 & 18 All Campers Access to the pit will begin on Friday after 5pm. If you show up before 5pm you will not be able to get in. All campers must be gone Sunday afternoon/early evening after the race.
- Limited parking area - please park parallel, NO END TO END OR CIRCLES
- Quiet time 10:00 PM till 6:00 AM
- Concessions available
- Portable toilets provided, no other services
- Fires in containers only, **NO open fires, NO fires directly on dirt**
- No pit bikes, quads or golf carts, race bikes only
- 10 mph speed limit on entry road and in pit area
- Staging/camping area is on private property, keep it neat for future use
- Trash bags will be provided, **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT**
- There will be a lot of prizes from sponsors to be handed out..
- At ALL checks, be advised you WILL need to go thru the scoring station SINGLE FILE! If you attempt to go thru passing another rider, you WILL NOT BE SCORED! Also, please do not roost the check workers. The special test check-ins are live engine, 1 minute intervals and riders should line up side by side with the other rider from your row. We will

- have flip cards at each check in so you will know when your row is coming up to start. You will start into a short section that will narrow into a single line to run you thru the transponder reader. This is where you need to be single file. Your time thru the section begins once you pass the transponder reader. It does not affect your scoring as to what order riders go thru the scoring station, only your elapsed time thru the section counts.
- Upon finishing, we will be bringing in all of the data from check points and enter the scoring into the computer system. As soon as scoring is complete it will be posted on a large board in the sign-up area. We expect each loop to be scored shortly after the last rider for that section completes it and the data reader is back to the pit area. Be patient please.
 - T-shirts will be available for purchase on race day.
 - Will have concessions available for breakfast, lunch and post race snacks on race day. We will also have a nice spaghetti dinner available for Saturday night for \$10 per person.
 - Before you leave, please remember to police your area for any trash. Also, the 10 mph speed limit is in affect while leaving as well.
 - This format may seem confusing after reading all this, but it really is not. All you really need to know is what time to be at the start of each loop. We will have charts at sign-up to tell you this information based on your row number.
 - Please remember that you are racing the clock. If someone comes up behind you, pull over as quickly as you can and let them go. If you are the one overtaking another competitor, give them a chance to pull over.
 - **No pit bikes**, quads, or golf carts are to be used at any time unless you are race support staff and have been given permission. **Race bikes only!!**

- 96db sound test per SAE - J1287 Standard - No Refunds for Failing
- USFS Approved Spark Arrestor
- Assigned Race Number – Will be Available at registration
- Kill Switch
- Helmet

- Chest Protector
- Gloves and Boots
- Fuel line secured at all places by safety wire or hose clamps.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- AA pre-entry is \$80.
- A, B, C and Sportsman division on-line or mail-in pre-entry is \$55. Pre-entry closes on October 15, 2008. \$60 fee at the event.
- Kids race is \$10, AMA membership is required.
- NO CHECKS ACCEPTED DAY OF EVENT, CASH ONLY.
- 500 RIDER LIMIT, get your entries in early.
- An automatic scoring system will be used and will require a transponder that can be purchased for \$20, or rented for the day for \$5 with a \$20 deposit from NEPG. (\$15 refund upon return of transponder) AMRA Transponders will work with NEPG scoring system. We WILL check your transponder to ensure our reader can pick it up.
- AMA Membership Required. Do not send membership fees with your entry! You must bring proof of existing AMA membership to registration or you must pay again to participate.
- We will give you numbers at sign-up. Please have your numbers on before going to technical inspection.
- AMA Memberships available for purchase at registration.

- From I-17 or 99th Ave Take Highway 74 West past Lake Pleasant to mile post 10. Take a right and follow the dirt road and signs to the staging area (approx 7 1/2 miles – follow the arrows).
- From Hwy 60 or 221th Ave Take 74 East to mile post 10. Take a left and follow the dirt road and signs to the staging area (approx 7 1/2 miles – follow the arrows).
