

AMRA 7-9 year old 50cc's will now be the Webe only 50 class. This is an ageless 50cc class, so we won't have any problems with the 9 year olds entering this class, but the kids won't receive any National points.

AMRA 50cc 4-6 year olds will still enter the 50cc 4-6 year old National class.

As for the Big Bikes. All is well, as you can see on the Webe entry form there is now a 201-250cc class for Webe and AMRA only, no National points. This is for AMRA racers on 250cc 4 strokes and 250cc 2 strokes. If you are running for National points and AMRA points, please email me.

As for AMRA's Youth class. If you are in this class and run a 150cc or less displacement you will enter Ironman Mini. If you run anything bigger than a 150cc displacement bike, then you will enter the appropriate class. Ie: if you're on a KTM 200, you enter the 86cc-200cc Class, if you're on a 250 you'll run in the 201-250cc class. You will be trophied in these respective classes and then we'll pull you out and assign you AMRA points separately. Please contact me if you are in AMRA's Youth Class.

AMRA Pro's will be running with the Webe and National Pro's.

Lastly 65's and 85's, if you are an AMRA Advanced rider you enter 65 or 85 A. If you are an AMRA Beginner in the 65 or 85 Division then you enter 65 or 85 C.
